

# METRO AIR PARKWAY CONSTRUCTION: I-5 DETOUR APRIL 16 & 17 Closure Part of Metro Air Parkway Interchange Construction

Sacramento CA – The Sacramento County Department of Transportation (SacDOT) will conduct two overnight closures southbound and northbound I-5 at the Metro Air Parkway interchange construction project. Construction crews will close southbound I-5 on Friday night, April 16, at 11 p.m., and reopen Saturday morning April 17, at 6 a.m. Crews will close northbound I-5 on Saturday night, April 17, at 10 p.m. and reopen Sunday morning April 18, at 5 a.m. In conjunction with Caltrans, SacDOT contractors will perform work over the northbound and southbound lanes. During the closures, vehicles will be detoured along the following routes:

#### SATURDAY, APRIL 16, 2021

- SOUTHBOUND I-5 Closure: Friday 11 p.m., to Saturday 6 a.m.
  - Detour will be to divert traffic off of southbound I-5 to Airport Boulevard and proceed onto Bayou Way, then left on Power Line Road, then right on West Elkhorn Boulevard to SR-99 south to I-5 south.

#### **SUNDAY, APRIL 17, 2021**

- NORTHBOUND I-5 Closure: Saturday 10 p.m., to Sunday 5 a.m.
  - Detour will be to divert traffic off northbound I-5 to the new Metro Air Parkway off ramp and back onto I-5 on the new Metro Air Parkway on ramp.



SacDOT expects to complete the \$17.9 million project in summer of 2021.
